

The Chicago Booth Executive Program is an application-based program and includes a formal admissions process. The process has two main components:

1. Application - please submit an application through our online portal
2. Admissions Interview - interviews are by invitation only

Application

In order for your application to be considered complete, we require the following to be submitted through our online portal:

1. Required application questions
2. CV/Resume
3. Letter of Recommendation: this should be completed by your direct manager or supervisor. If you are self-sponsoring, please submit two letters of recommendation. These letters should be submitted by previous managers or individuals who are well acquainted with your performance in a work setting.

All application materials are required in order to be considered for the program.

Admissions Interview

Interviews will be granted on an invitation-only basis after submission of a completed application. Receiving an invitation to interview does not guarantee admission. All interviews will be held with a member of the Chicago Booth team via Zoom.

Admission FAQs

What do you look for in an applicant?

Our aim is to create a diverse and dynamic class, which fosters a rich and impactful learning experience for everyone. We evaluate candidates based on a holistic process that incorporates every component of the application. While title, seniority and industry are considered, they are not the only deciding factors. We are also interested in your learning objectives, professional goals and the impact the program will have on your organization and team.

When we evaluate applicants, there are several qualities that we find particularly valuable and strong indicators you will be successful in the program. These qualities include adaptability and willingness to work in diverse teams; the capacity to lead and motivate others; and the desire to be collaborative and engage others respectfully.

Questions While Submitting an Application:

I'm having issues with submitting an application, can you help?

We recommend candidates:

1. Use Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox as a browser.

2. Save a copy of your answers in a word document. This is helpful should you want to reference your answers at a later time.
3. Complete the application in one sitting.

We will be offering another Chicago Booth Executive Program in El Gouna in 2021 and strongly encourage all applicants who were not accepted to reapply in the coming year.
